(i) Tournament Information

Proper attire is required. Your attire reflects the way that our potential sponsors, the media and the general public view our players and our sport. Please do your part and dressing accordingly.

No Personal checks will be accepted.

Youth will **only** be allowed to play in the Friday Luck of the Draw (LOD) with advance permission from the Tournament Director. <u>This will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis</u>. Youth will **NOT** be allowed to register for Youth **and** Adult events that run concurrently. If this situation arises, the Youth member will be withdrawn from the Adult event. Please ensure that this does not occur.

We use a computer generated random numbering system to set our brackets and determine blind draw partners. TADA has used this system for over 20 years and find that it has worked extremely well.

To have a 2nd or 3rd match call made you must present the registration ticket to the Control Desk so that the appropriate time can be marked. No 2nd or 3rd calls will be done without this ticket.

Once your match has been called please proceed immediately to the Control Desk to retrieve your tickets and chalkers paper and then report to the appropriate board.

<u>ABSOLUTELY NO OUTSIDE</u> food or beverages <u>any</u> kind will be allowed in or around the darting area. Doing so will result in ejection from the tournament.

If you have prepaid for your weekend events you must still fill out a registration ticket and turn it in for each event. Your name will be on a list noting that you have prepaid. Any questions or concerns please see Tournament Director. When registering for an event, PLEASE **print** your **full name** on line 1 of the registration ticket and then mark the appropriate event box on the bottom of the ticket. You DO NOT need to fill in your address, etc. For SINGLES EVENTS we also require your ADO affiliation. Your ADO affiliation is the local league that you play for. If you have any Individual membership to ADO, please mark the Association line with IND. This information is required so we can ensure that the winner's points can be properly recorded and filed with the ADO. We do allow nicknames on your registration form as long as they are not offensive and your full name is printed below it. Registration will close at the posted event time and the scheduled event will start shortly thereafter.

Please support our vendors and sponsors. They contribute generously to our charities, Virginia Area 2 Special Olympics and the Lupus Foundation of America.

Be a good winner. Thank the chalker, shake your opponents hand, have a celebration toast with your partner and then **PLEASE** return your match ticket to the Tournament Control Desk and place it in the winner's box. Help us to keep your tournament running on time.

We do our best to recruit the most talented and conscientious volunteers possible. Please remember that without these **volunteers** there wouldn't be a tournament staff which means there wouldn't be a tournament. We ask that you treat our volunteers with the respect that they deserve.

If you see a red dollar sign on your match ticket it means that you are "in the money". This means that you will need to bring your ticket to the control desk for processing to receive your payout. Please do this promptly after being eliminated.
